Etowah Woman Dies in Kentucky

An Etowah woman was killed in a traffic accident on I-75 in Kentucky on the morning of July 4th. Kentucky State Police say the crash took place at mile marker 68 northbound. Police believe the driver of a passenger car was slowing or stopped when a commercial vehicle rear-ended it. A passenger in one of the vehicles, 67vear-old Susan C. Webber of Etowah, was pronounced dead at the scene. The driver was taken to a hospital in Berea, Kentucky with life-threatening injuries.
