More Problems on Highway 68

Motorists who use Highway 68 from Spring City up the mountain to Crossville have had a rough go of it in the past 16 months. In April of 2018, the mountain fell away, taking one lane of State Route 68 with it between Spring City and Grandview. At one point the road had to be completely closed. Now, a year later, the road surface has developed cracks a half-mile away. TDOT spokesman Jennifer Flynn says the problem was caused by heavy rains in February. Currently, traffic is down to one lane. Flynn says they believe they can keep one lane open while repairs are being made.
