MONDAY'S MARKET REPORT: U.S. stocks mostly fell on increasing geopolitical risks and global growth concerns. Crude oil prices surged higher after a drone attack on Saudi Arabia's oil facilities disrupted 5% of global crude supply. The United Auto Workers union went on strike at General Motors. U.S. Treasuries rose. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 143 points or 0.5% to 27,077. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 10 points or 0.3% to 2,998, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 23 points or 0.3% to 8,154.

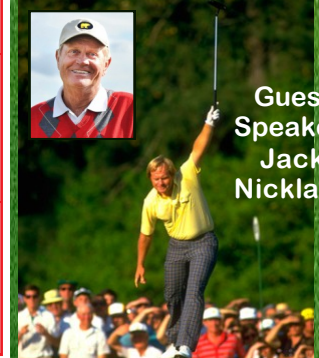

1787 - The U.S. Constitution was signed by a majority of the 55 delegates to the constitutional convention in Philadelphia. It then went to the individual states for ratification.

1796 - President George Washington delivered his farewell address, warning the American people to avoid foreign alliances.

1911 - The first transcontinental airplane flight, from New York City to Pasadena, CA, was accomplished on this day. It took C.P. Rogers only 82 hours to fly across the U.S.
