The Athens Municipal Building, Public Works, Recycle Center, and Animal Shelter will be closed Monday in observance of Veterans Day. Residential garbage routes for Monday will be picked up on Tuesday.

- Athens Lutheran Church will serve a free breakfast to veterans and their families on Saturday, Nov. 9th, from 7:30 to 10:30 a.m. The church is located at 710 Forrest Ave.
- A Veterans Day Parade will be held in Etowah starting at 3 p.m. Saturday.
- On Veterans Day, there will be the annual ceremony at 11 a.m. at the Athens VFW Post.
- Etowah Post 100 of the American Veterans (AmVets) along with the sons of the AmVets and the AmVets Ladies Auxiliary will have a Veterans Day ceremony at 11 a.m. Monday. The McMinn County High School Band will play, and the speaker will be Ret. USAF Colonel Donald Edmands, Jr. Lunch will be served after the ceremony. The event is open to the public and is located at 205 County Road 813 in Etowah. A golf cart will be available to carry veterans to the ceremony.
