♦ GREENE TO HEAD ATHENS SCHOOLS

A familiar name is returning to serve as the new Director of Schools for the Athens City School System. Robert Greene was

chosen this week to replace Dr. Melanie Miller, who is retiring. Greene began his career in Meigs County where he served as teacher, coach, and eventually school superintendent of schools for 25 years. He was superintendent of the Athens schools from 2011-2015. He also served as the Deputy Commissioner of Education for the State of Tennessee and later was superintendent of the Dayton City School. Greene is a graduate of Tennessee Wesleyan. He also served as a school principal,



teacher, and coach in Monroe County. The Athens School Board approved a three-year contract for Greene at a salary of \$109,489 per year. He will assume his new duties in Athens on July 1st.
