Police/Fire Reports for Feb.

The Athens City Council received the monthly reports for February activity from the police and fire departments at its meeting this past Tuesday evening.

- Police Chief Cliff Couch reported there were 33 thefts in February, 8 assaults, 4 motor vehicle thefts, and 3 burglaries. There were 39 arrests for drug violations. Officers issued 145 citations for moving violations. There were 67 traffic accidents in Athens during February, with 5 injuries. There is currently one vacancy on the police department.

- Fire Chief Brandon Ainsworth reported that firefighters responded to 154 calls in February. Seventy-two of the calls were for rescue and emergency medical service. Seventeen were to fires. There were 35 false alarms.
