Latest Count of Virus Cases

The Tennessee Department of Health reports as of Wednesday evening there were 2,683 cases of coronavirus in the state. There have been 24 deaths. The number of cases in McMinn County remains at 3 positive tests and there have been 114 negative tests. Monroe County reports 3 cases. Meigs County still has 1. Rhea County has 1 case. Bradley County is reporting 14 cases. The CEO of Starr Regional Medical Centers of Athens and Etowah will be interviewed on WYXI Radio AM-1390 & FM 94.5 on the 8 a.m. news Thursday morning to discuss how Starr is dealing with the virus.
