A new postage stamp commemorating the 100th anniversary of the ratification of the 19th Amendment will be held this Saturday, August 29th, at 12:30 p.m. at the Niota Depot. The public is invited to view the new stamp. Stamps, envelopes, and other memorabilia will be for sale at the event. Masks and a safe distance will be required inside the depot. The 19th Amendment gave women the right to vote. Harry T. Burn, from Niota cast the deciding vote.

✓ Athens Utilities Board has a new Interactive Voice Response (IVR) number that customers can use to make bill payments over the phone. That number is 888-643-1081. When using the new IVR number, AUB customers will begin by entering the first six numbers of their new AUB account number. The new account number is six numbers, a hyphen, then another six numbers. You would use just the first six numbers to begin with the new IVR. The new system will allow an AUB customer to pay via debit card, credit card, or an electronic check using the check routing number.

The Southeast Tennessee Human Resource Agency (SETHRA) will be distributing USDA commodities to eligible Meigs County residents on Wednesday, September 2nd, starting at 8 a.m. Distribution will be at the SETHRA office in Decatur. You must have a sheet in order to receive commodities on this day. All you have to provide is proof of income for all household members or proof of category eligibility to get your commodity sheet.
