Burn Permit Season is Here

The Tennessee Division of Forestry reminds you that burn per-

mits for leaf and brush piles will be required beginning this Thursday, October 15th, as the official wildfire season begins. Permits are issued only when conditions are conducive to safe burning. If you live inside a city, there may be additional restrictions. should check with



your local fire department. Burning without a permit is a Class C misdemeanor, punishable by up to 30 days in jail and/or a fine. Wildfires caused by arson are a felony punishable by 3 to 15 years in prison. Debris Burn Permits are available online at no charge: www.BurnSafeTN.org
