Names Released in Fatal Wreck

The Tennessee Highway Patrol has released the names of the two men who were killed in a Friday night traffic accident on Highway 310 near Etowah. They were Joseph M. Millsaps, 29, of Etowah, and Harold Williams, 51, of Englewood. Millsaps was the driver of a Toyota Camry and Williams was a passenger. The THP says Millsaps was going around a curve when his car went into a skid and crossed the center line, hitting an oncoming Pontiac Montana head-on. Millsaps and Williams were dead at the scene. The driver of the Montana, 34-year-old Robert M. Gentry of Englewood, was injured, along with six juveniles in the van, ranging in age from 1 to 15.
