Details Released on Wacker Accident

We're learning new details two months after a deadly industrial accident at the Wacker Plant in Charleston. At the time plant officials said five contract workers were injured during a leak at the plant, and one of those workers died. Now an autopsy report obtained through an open records request reveals new details about his death. According to the postmortem examination, 22-year-old Jesus Montes Aguilar died at 10:59 a.m. on November 13th, 2020, of "multiple blunt force injuries" when he fell from a "height." According to Wacker, four other contractors were injured when there was a small release of steam and hydrochloric acid.

THURSDAY'S MARKET REPORT: Equities finished mixed ahead of the new administration's stimulus-plan announcement. The S&P 500 approached all-time highs before pulling back later in the day. Investors balanced the likelihood of further government aid against near-term economic headwinds. The energy, real estate and financial sectors gained. Communication services and technology lagged, dragging the S&P 500 into negative territory. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 68.95 to 30,991.52. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 14.30 to 3,795.54, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 16.31 to 13,112.64.
