Sonic Drive-In Closed Due to Wreck

The Sonic Drive-In located on Decatur Pike is closed indefinitely for repairs after a traffic accident last Sunday afternoon. Athens Fire Chief Brandon Ainsworth says the Fire Department was dispatched to a motor vehicle accident and, on arrival, found a single vehicle that had struck the building causing extensive damage to the structure. Chief Ainsworth says the area damaged from the crash was the kitchen area around the deep fryers. He says the intrusion into the building caused severe damage, dislodging the hood fire suppression system and moving the cooking appliances approximately 4 to 5 feet. Firefighters assessed the driver of the car and also evacuated employees from the building due to the damage to the structure. No employees were injured as a result of the crash. Athens Utilities Board responded to secure the power and natural gas. The day after the crash, the building was inspected by building official Gene McConkey to further look into the damage to the structure. At this point, it is unknown how long Sonic will be closed for repairs. Meantime, the building and lot have been taped off with yellow caution tape.

Update on Fatal Shooting

Athens police have released the name of the young man who died

from a gunshot wound Wednesday afternoon. Police Chief Cliff Couch says officers were called to Walthall Street in reference to gunshots being fired. They found a young male, identified as 21-year-old Zavion Ferguson of Athens, lying in the grassy area next to the basketball courts. He had been shot, and died on the scene. After working through the night, officers charged Logan Rowe, 18, of Niota, with 2nd degree murder.
