Fuel Delivery Problems Noted

The price of gasoline is expected to go up this week as a result of a ransomware attack that halted all operations of the Colonial pipeline over the weekend. Colonial delivers 45% of the fuel consumed along the east coast. A branch of the pipeline goes through Athens and McMinn County. Ransomware attacks are typically carried out by criminal hackers, who demand a large payment to remove it. Colonial says the attack affected some of its information technology systems and that the company immediately halted pipeline operations. The Alpharetta, Georgia-based company transports gasoline, diesel, jet fuel, and home heating oil from refineries on the Gulf Coast through pipelines running from Texas to New Jersey. Oil industry experts say an outage of several days could cause shortages and price hikes, particularly in an area stretching from central Alabama to the Washington, D.C., area. That would include the Athens area.
