- ◆ If you've been living on those hefty unemployment checks during the pandemic, it's time to start looking for a job. Governor Lee has announced the end of all federally funded pandemic unemployment compensation programs in Tennessee effective July 3rd. The governor says Tennesseans have access to more than 250,000 jobs across the state, and many companies, restaurants, and factories are desperate for workers.
- ◆ Jennifer Letner, the former PTO treasurer at Tellico Plains Elementary School, has been indicted on charges of theft over \$10,000. The Tennessee Comptroller's Office says Letner stole at least \$22,932. She admitted to investigators that she was experiencing financial difficulties and used PTO funds to pay personal living expenses, including payments for car loans, mobile phone service, and other personal items.
- The Athens City School Board will have a called meeting at 5:30 p.m. today at the Administration Building. The purpose of the meeting is to discuss and vote on taking off the table the Approval of Extending the Athens City Schools Mask Mandate.

WEDNESDAY'S MARKET REPORT: Equities declined for the third consecutive day and bond yields climbed as inflation in April accelerated more than expected; a 4.2% increase in consumer prices from a year ago, far higher than the 3.6% expected rate. The Dow Jones Industrial Average closed at 33,587.66, down 681.50. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was 4,063.04, down 89.06, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was 13,031.68, down 357.74.
