• Allen Douglas Boyd, died Sunday at the University of Tennessee Medical Center in Knoxville. He served with the 380th Bomb Group and with the 375th Troop carrier Group in the South Pacific during World War II. He served on the Pentagon Air National Guard Personnel Advisory Council completing over 41 years of active and reserve military duty. He was president of The National Guard Association of Tennessee from 1970-1972. After retiring from the military, Colonel Boyd served as Executive Director of The United Way of McMinn County for five years. A memorial service will be held at a later date.
