## TWU Names New President

The Tennessee Wesleyan University Board of Trustees has named Dr.

Tyler Forrest to become the next President of the University effective July 1, 2022. Dr. Forrest is currently the Vice Chancellor for Finance and Administration at the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga. He will be the first TWU President to have been born and raised in Athens, where he resides with his wife, Emily, and their two children, Caroline and Benjamin. The Board elected Dr. Forrest for his financial and administrative expertise and natural leadership skills. Dr. Bobby Goodfriend, TWU Board Chair, commented that "Tyler Forrest is the right person at the right time. He has the background to build on the exceptional accomplishments



of retiring President Dr. Harley Knowles. **FRIDAY'S MARKET REPORT:** The S&P 500 was down about 20% from its peak, but closed flat for the day. There were no economic releases or new catalysts for the midday weakness. International sentiment got a boost following moves by China to shore up its economy. The Chinese central bank unexpectedly cut the five-year loan prime rate to 4.45% from 5%. This is the biggest reduction since 2019. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 8.77 to 31,261.90. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up .57 to 3,901.36, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 33.88 to 11,354.62.
