### **Blair Indicted on Additional Charges**

A McMinn County woman previously indicted by the McMinn County Grand Jury on numerous charges related to sexual encounters with minors, has been indicted on additional charges. According to Sheriff Joe Guy, the case began with a referral from the Tennessee Department of Children's Services on December 9, 2021, that indicated Melissa A.



Blair, 38, of Englewood, had been having sexual encounters with male juveniles who students were at McMinn Central High School. An investigation immediately began, and as interviews progressed, additional information came to light, as well as additional victims. The February 15th Grand Jury indicted Melissa A Blair on numerous charges, and she was booked into the

McMinn Co Jail and later released upon making a \$100,000 bond. "Our investigation has continued over the past few months," said Sheriff Joe Guy, "in which additional victims were identified, and these cases were presented to the Grand Jury on June 21st which resulted in additional indictments against Melissa A Blair." ## **Blair Indictment Continued**

The indictments from the June 21 Grand Jury were a total of 20 counts, including:

Solicitation of a Minor (3 Counts)

Solicitation of Sexual Exploitation of a Minor by Electronic Means (4 counts)

**Patronizing Prostitution (5 Counts)** Aggravated Statutory Rape (6 counts) Sexual Exploitation of a Minor

These new charges are related to 9 new confirmed male juvenile victims, related to incidents which occurred from Spring of 2020 through late 2021," said Sheriff Guy. "At the time of these incidents involving Melissa A Blair, the males were between the ages of 15 and 17. It appears in these cases, as before, that Ms. Blair was communicating with the juveniles on social media, arranging meetings with them, and trading items for sexual encounters with them. These latest 9 victims, added to the 9 victims previously discovered before the February 15th Grand Jury, brings a total number of 18 male juvenile victims in this case."Sheriff Guy added that Melissa A Blair was taken into custody and was booked into the McMinn County Jail and faces a \$1,000,000 bond. The case will be set for an upcoming McMinn County Criminal Court.

# **Today in History**

**1541** - Spanish conquistador Francisco de Orellana, the first European to sail down Brazil's Amazon River, fought a famous battle with warrior women. The women were described as tall with long braided hair wound around their heads. They resembled the fighting women of ancient Greek legend, the Amazons, so much, that the river where the battle took place has been called the Amazon ever since.

**1895** - Heavyweight boxing champ Jack Demsey was born. **1948** - Russia blockaded the western zones of Berlin, obstructing all rail, water, and highway routes. This set the stage for the "Berlin Airlift," in which the Western allies flew in supplies to meet the needs of more than 2-million people in West Berlin.

**1949** - The movie features of Hopalong Cassidy premiered on TV. The films were edited to thirty and sixty-minute versions starring William Boyd as Hopalong and Edgar Buchanan as his sidekick, Red Connors. Eventually, all 66 original films were shown on TV, so Boyd produced more *Hopalong Cassidy* episodes just for TV.

**1975** - An Eastern Airlines Boeing 727 crashed at New York's Kennedy International Airport, killing 114.
