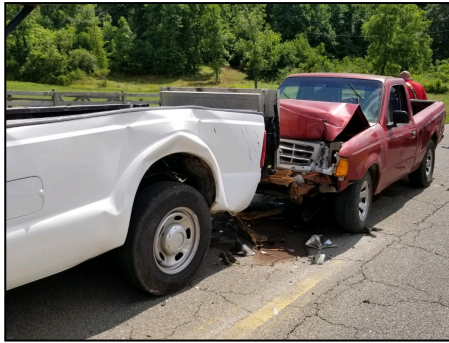

## Today in History

**1814** - The American firearms inventor, Samuel Colt, was born. Colt's revolver, or "six-shooter" as it was known, used an automatically-revolving set of chambers.

**1937** - Singer George Hamilton IV was born. Among his hit records, "A Rose And A Baby Ruth," "Abilene," and "Why Don't They Understand."

**1942** - Singer Vicki Carr was born. Her real name is Florencia Martinez Cardona. Her hit records include "It Must Be Him" and "The Lesson."

**1969** - Apollo 11 and its astronauts, Neil Armstrong, Edwin "Buzz" Aldrin and Michael Collins, went into orbit around the moon.

**1969** - John Fairfax of Britain arrived at Fort Lauderdale, Florida, after rowing across the Atlantic Ocean alone. He was the first person to accomplish that feat. His journey lasted 178 days.

**1996** - The Centennial Olympics opened in Atlanta.

## National News

♦ Federal prosecutors in New York and the Department of Labor are inspecting Amazon warehouses around the country as part of a civil investigation into unsafe and unseemly workplace conditions.

♦ Prosecutors plan to charge a Los Angeles man in connection with three murders across Southern California last week. Malik Patt, 20, has been linked to the fatal shooting of a homeless man in Los Angeles on July 9, as well as the July 11 deaths of a 7-Eleven clerk in Brea and a man who intervened in a robbery in a 7-Eleven parking lot in Santa Ana. Patt faces multiple charges, including murder, attempted murder, robbery and carjacking. If convicted, he could receive the death penalty or a life sentence without the possibility of parole.

**MONDAY'S MARKET REPORT** Markets erased opening gains after Apple announced a slowdown in hiring and capital spending amid growing economic growth headwinds. European and Asian shares were higher. Oil was up more than 4%. The dollar weakened somewhat as the probability of a 100 bps Federal Reserve rate hike came down. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 215.65 to 31,072.61. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 32.31 to 3,830.85, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 92.37 to 11,360.05.

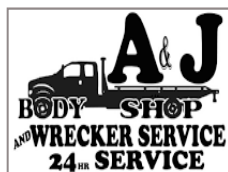
