Little League Baseball is for boys and girls ages 4 to 12 and Wittle Weague baseball is for boys and girls ages three and four. The fee for Little League is \$75 per player, which includes a jersey, pants, hat, belt, socks, and secondary medical insurance. The Wittle Weague fee is \$25 per player, which includes a T-shirt jersey and secondary medical insurance. All games will be played exclusively at the Athens Regional Park, and admission is free. Games will be played on weekdays and on Saturdays. Registration is available online at athenstn.gov/parks for no additional fee. Those paying with cash or checks must do so at the Recreation office located at Athens City Hall. A copy of each player's birth certificate is required for Little League and must be on file prior to participation. Volunteers are needed for coaches and team parents. Anyone wishing to be considered as a coach, assistant coach, or league volunteer must complete a coach/volunteer application prior to March 6th and must pass a background check prior to any team activities. MONDAY'S MARKET REPORT

Equities closed moderately lower as markets regroup following last week's gains, which closed out January with a 6% increase for the month. The 10-year Treasury yield moved back above 3.6% after dropping below 3.35% last week. The increase in rates provided a lift to the U.S. dollar. Oil moved higher after a sharp drop last week that pushed crude prices below \$74 per barrel. The price of WTI Crude Oil was up .37 to 74.48. At the closing bell, the Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 34.99 to 33,891.02. The S&P 500 was down 25.40 to 4,111.08, and The Nasdaq Composite was down 119.50 to 11,887.45.

Today In History

1812 - Novelist Charles Dickens was born in England. His best-known books include "A Christmas Carol," "Great Expectations," and "Oliver Twist."

1885 - Author Sinclair Lewis was born in Minnesota. He wrote such novels as "Main Street" and "Babbitt." In 1930, Lewis became the first American author to win the Nobel Prize for Literature.

1947 - The Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered in caves a few miles from Jericho. They date from around 200 B.C. to 100 A.D. They are the oldest known manuscripts of any books of the Bible. They include all of the books of the Old Testament except Esther.

1962 - President John F. Kennedy imposed a full trade embargo on Cuba.

1990 - The Soviet Union's Communist Party gave up its monopoly on power by agreeing to let other political parties compete for control of the country.
