Dr. Ben Carson Coming to Athens



The Athens Area Chamber of Commerce has announced that Dr. Ben Carson will be the speaker for the Athens Chamber 18th Annual Benefit on Saturday, June 14, 2025.

Dr. Ben Carson is an American neurosurgeon and former politician. He gained fame for his work in pediatric neurosurgery, notably separating conjoined twins in 1987. Carson served as the Director of Pediatric Neurosurgery at Johns Hopkins Hospital. He is also an accomplished author, with "Gifted Hands" being his most famous book. In 2016, Carson ran for the Republican presidential nomination and later served as the U.S. Secretary of Housing and Urban Development from 2017 to 2021. Carson received the Presidential Medal of Freedom in 2008 for his contributions to medicine and public service.

TN Unemployment Remains at Historic Low



Tennessee maintains recordlow unemployment at 3% in June, unchanged from May's all-time low, according to the Department of Labor and Workforce Development (TDLWD). This

rate is a 0.1 percentage point decrease from June 2023. Employers added 400 jobs between May and June, with notable gains in mining, logging, construction, education, and health services. Despite these gains, nonfarm employment decreased by 5,900 jobs over the year, with significant losses in administrative, support, waste services, real estate, and non-durable goods manufacturing sectors.

Nationally, the unemployment rate rose from 4% to 4.1% in June, 0.5 percentage points higher than in June 2023.

TDLWD offers resources for job seekers, including TNWorkReady, the virtual American Job Center, and Jobs4TN. The June 2024 county unemployment data will be released on July 25, 2024.

Today In History - July 19

1814 - The American firearms inventor, Samuel Colt, was born. Colt's revolver, or "six-shooter" as it was known, used an automatically-revolving set of chambers.

1848 - The women's suffrage movement in the United States was launched with the opening of the Seneca Falls Convention, which sought to gain certain rights and privileges for women, notably the right to vote.

1969 - Apollo 11 and its astronauts, Neil Armstrong, Edwin "Buzz" Aldrin and Michael Collins, went into orbit around the moon.

1969 - John Fairfax of Britain arrived at Fort Lauderdale, Florida, after rowing across the Atlantic Ocean alone. He was the first person to accomplish that feat. His journey lasted 178 days.
