Early Voting Ends Saturday

The last day to vote early in the August 1st State Primary and McMinn County General Election will be this Saturday, July 27th. The absentee ballot request deadline is today, Thursday, July 25th. Here in McMinn County, there will be only two contested races. There are 3 qualified candidates on the ballot for the Etowah City Commission running for 2 seats. The second contested race is the City of Etowah School Board where there are 3 qualified candidates running for 2 seats. In the state primary election there is only one contested race and that is for the U.S. Senate. Current Senator Marsha Blackburn, who is running for re-election, is facing Tres Wittum in the Republican primary. In the Democratic Primary, there are 4 names on the ballot. Election day will be next Thursday, August 1st.

Two Men in Custody After Trooper Shooting in Putnam County



A second man is now in custody in Davidson County along with Braze Rucker after shooting and injuring a Tennessee Highway Patrol officer during a traffic stop on Friday near Nashville. Officials with the Tennessee Highway Patrol say Timothy L. Davis Jr. will be booked on charges relating to the shooting of Trooper Adam Cothron along with Rucker, who was caught Sunday. 29-year-old Rucker was found and arrested

by Kentucky State Police in Princeton, Kentucky, which is North of Hopkinsville and about two hours away from where the suspects' car was recovered by law enforcement in Gallatin, Tennessee. Rucker was the passenger in the car. Trooper Cothron was injured in the shooting, but is stable. Doctors say that a bullet remains lodged in his shoulder blade and they will not attempt to remove it unless his body tries to remove on its own. *Photo Courtesy of THP Twitter*

1866 - Ulysses S. Grant was named General of the Army, the first officer to hold the rank.
