

Gas Prices Fall After Hurricanes Helene and Milton



Gas prices nationwide have dropped by two cents last week, bringing the average to \$3.13 per gallon, eight cents less than a month ago and 34 cents less than a year ago, according to the latest report. McMinn County gas prices average around \$2.72 per gallon.

Electric vehicle (EV) owners, including AAA's 1.2 million members with at least one EV at home, are seeing similar trends. The average kilowatt-hour cost at public charging stations dipped by one cent to 34 cents nationally. Despite a slight increase in gas demand—rising

from 8.83 to 9.15 million barrels per day (b/d) domestic gasoline stocks decreased to 210.9 million barrels, while production also dipped, averaging 9.7 million b/d.

The Energy Information Administration (EIA) reports that U.S. crude oil inventories have decreased by

0.5 million barrels, reaching 425.5 million barrels, which is about 4% below the five-year seasonal average. WTI (West Texas Intermediate) crude oil closed at \$69.49 per barrel on Friday.



Planning Commission Meeting Today

The Athens Municipal-Regional Planning Commission will meet on Today, November 4, at 12:00 pm in the Conference Room to approve minutes from previous sessions and discuss new business, including final plat approvals. The agenda includes approving a plat for Scott Underwood's property on Hicks Street and Eastanal-lee Avenue, consolidating three lots into one on a 1.48-acre parcel. Additionally, a final plat request from the City of Athens and William Robinson will be reviewed, creating a 30-foot right-of-way on View Street and Rock Street while leaving a 2.74-acre residential lot. Both plats have received necessary departmental approvals and certificate signatures, with staff recommending their approval. The meeting will also allow time for public comments,. No old business or staff reports are expected.

Traffic Control Worker Killed in Cleveland

The Tennessee Highway Patrol reported that a pedestrian was struck Thursday morning on Interstate 75 North, just south of APD 40. The two right lanes of Interstate 75 were blocked while Emergency crews were on the scene. An investigation has now begun concerning the death of a Superior Traffic Control worker in the Thursday morning incident. Superior Traffic Control notified Tennesee OSHA (TOSHA) of the fatality on Thursday. The Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development says that the investigative process will include surveying the location, reviewing company records and procedures, and interviewing management as well as employees. An investiga-

tion of this nature could take up to six months to complete. In the meantime, TOSHA will not release any preliminary information until the investigation is complete.
