

THP Looking to Identify Woman Found in Roane Co.




The Tennessee Highway Patrol (THP) is seeking the public's assistance in identifying an unidentified female found lying in the emergency lane of Interstate 40 eastbound in Roane County, one mile east of exit 340, the Rockwood Municipal Airport Road near the 341-mile marker, on Oct. 13, at approximately 8:17 p.m. She succumbed to her injuries at the UT Medical Center.

The unidentified female is African American, 5'3" to 5'5" in height, approximately 38 years old, weighing 170 to 175 pounds, and has a mole on the bridge of her nose. She has no tattoos. Investigators are actively seeking any information that may help determine her identity.


Volunteers Defeat Wildcats, Look to MS State





Tennessee head coach Josh Heupel and his team are staying focused on the present rather than the upcoming release of the College Football Playoff rankings, where No. 7 Tennessee will likely place in the top 12. The Vols, currently 7-1 overall and 4-1 in the SEC, recently defeated Kentucky, extending their win streak to three games. Their only loss this season was at Arkansas, and they boast strong wins over both Alabama and Florida, positioning them as serious playoff contenders. However, Heupel has maintained that the team's primary focus is on improving their performance and preparing for Mississippi State this weekend.

Though Tennessee is in a favorable spot, it hasn't been without challenges. The team has struggled to generate early offense, scoring just seven points in the first half across their last four games—a tendency that leaves little room for error in their playoff bid. Fortunately, the defense has stepped up, ranking near the top of most defensive metrics, forcing timely turnovers, and securing tight victories over key opponents like Alabama and Florida. Their recent three-turnover game against Kentucky was crucial in their 10-point win and showcased the defense's ability to keep them in contention even when the offense lags.

Looking ahead, Tennessee's best path to the playoffs is to win out, including their crucial matchup against No. 2 Georgia, which may determine both a spot in the SEC Championship and a playoff berth. They'll also face No. 24 Vanderbilt to close the season, and a single loss during this stretch could eliminate them from playoff contention. For now, Tennessee's priority remains refining their offensive consistency and securing wins, beginning with Mississippi State on Saturday. The Tennessee Volunteers take on Mississippi State Bulldogs at Neyland Stadium on Saturday, Nov. 9 at 7:00pm. The game will be televised on ESPN.
