

Niota and Sweetwater to Receive \$1,000,000 Each

Tennessee Governor Bill Lee and Economic and Community Development Commissioner Stuart С. McWhorter have approved \$26.6 million in Community Development Block Grants (CDBG) to support infrastructure, health, and safety initiatives across the state. Funded by HUD and administered by the Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development, the grants will assist rural communities with essential improvements, including water and sewer systems, safety projects, and enhancements to public facilities. The City of Niota will receive \$1Million for water system improvements and the City of Sweetwater will

receive \$1Million for Community Center improvements.

In addition to infrastructure upgrades, the grants will fund projects such as sidewalk and walking trail improvements, street paving, and new community centers to improve quality of life in rural areas. For a full listing of Grants, Click <u>HERE</u>
