TWU Leases Ingleside Property



Tennessee Wesleyan University (TWU) and the City of Athens have entered into a multi-year lease agreement to revitalize the former Ingleside School property, marking the largest expansion of TWU's campus in over 50 years. The nearly nine-acre site will be developed into a multi-purpose athletics facil-

ity, supporting TWU's soccer, lacrosse, and track and field teams, with shared use for the Athens Parks and Recreation Department.

"This partnership will benefit both TWU and the community," said TWU President Dr. Tyler Forrest. The facility, located just a quarter mile from TWU's downtown campus, will enhance local recreation options and serve as a gateway to Athens' key attractions. TWU also plans to preserve aspects of Ingleside School's historical significance as part of the redevelopment.

Coach Lewis "Peewee" Bivens Dead at 79



Lewis Carl "Pee Wee" Bivens, 79 of Etowah, passed away at Parkwest Hospital on Wednesday, October 30 due to complications from kidney failure.

His coaching career started at Calhoun's Elementary, Middle, and High School where he was a baseball and basketball coach. Carson Newman and Middle Tennessee State were next in his journey in girl's basketball where he has outstanding records at both universities. Bivens led the Lady Raiders from 1987 to 1997, amassing a 183-103 record, four OVC

regular-season titles, and two NCAA Tournament appearances. His adaptability and offensive strategy left a lasting impact on MTSU, including a standout 1995-96 season with a 24-6 record. Former players and colleagues praised Bivens for his dedication and resilience, particularly during the 1991-92 season when he overcame paralysis caused by health complications.

Bivens' legacy includes his influence on players like Heather Warren, a Hall of Fame guard who credited his leadership for shaping her career.



TN Unemployment Remains Low, Outpaces National Average



Tennessee's unemployment rate remains near historic lows, holding steady at 3.3% in October, according to the latest data from the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Develop-

ment. Although up slightly from 3.2% in September, the state's rate remains significantly below the national average of 4.1%.

Earlier this year, Tennessee hit a record low unemployment rate of 3% for three consecutive months. The October figure is two-tenths of a percentage point lower than the same period last year.

Tennessee employers added 2,600 nonfarm jobs between September and October, with the largest gains in education and health services. Over the past year, total nonfarm employment rose by 45,200 jobs, driven by growth in sectors like trade, transportation, and construction.
