Fatal Accident on John J. Duncan Pkwy.

On the morning of Thursday, November 21, Athens Police Department officers responded to a two-vehicle collision on John J. Duncan Parkway near Congress Parkway. The accident involved a Ford Fusion and a Ford F-150. Emergency services, including Athens Fire Department and EMS, provided care at the scene. The driver of the Ford F-150 was transported to Starr Athens Hospital with non-life-threatening injuries.

Tragically, the driver of the Ford Fusion, identified as 21 -year-old Athalie Cleminte of Ten Mile, Tennessee, was pronounced deceased at the scene. Preliminary investigations indicate that the Ford Fusion crossed the center line, causing the collision. No charges are pending at this time.

The City of Athens extends its deepest condolences to all affected by this tragedy. As the holiday season approaches, the Police Department urges everyone to prioritize safety and remain vigilant on the roads.



Small Plane Crashes on Shallowford Road in Chattanooga



Rush hour on Shallowford Road in Chattanooga turned into a spectacle Wednesday morning as federal investigators worked to examine and remove the wreckage of a Cessna 172

Skyhawk that crashed the evening prior. The single-engine plane, registered to Aero-Chatt out of Bradley County, went down Tuesday at 5:51 p.m., narrowly missing traffic and coming to rest in trees near the intersection of Shallowford Road and Airport Road. According to the FAA's initial report, engine issues forced the pilot to attempt an emergency return to Chattanooga Airport. Air traffic control audio captured the pilot reporting a "very rough" engine just moments before the crash.

Both occupants of the plane miraculously survived with minor injuries. One individual exited the wreckage on

their own, while Chattanooga firefighters extricated the second person, who was trapped inside. Emergency crews transported both to the hospital.

By Wednesday afternoon, crews carefully disassembled the damaged plane and removed it from the crash site. Investigators from the FAA and NTSB continue to examine the cause of the crash. Crystal Air, the plane's associated flight group, is fully cooperating with authorities.

Early Morning Fire Destroys Etowah Structure on Ohio Avenue



A structure fire on Ohio Avenue in Etowah broke out early Thursday morning, heavily damaging the home and an outbuilding. Fire crews arrived at approximately 1:30 a.m. to find the property fully engulfed in

flames. Fortunately, no one was home at the time of the fire.

Multiple agencies responded to the scene, including Etowah City Fire, Etowah Rural Fire, Englewood Rural Fire, Athens City Fire, and Madisonville City Fire. Assisting were AMR, Etowah Police Department, MCSO, Etowah Utilities Board, Etowah Public Works, and West Polk Fire Department, which stood by to support local departments.
