Etowah Senior Center Announces Digital Literacy Series



Etowah Senior Center is excited to announce its participation in a new nationwide effort aimed at improving digital literacy among older adults. This initiative, led by the National Council on Aging (NCOA) in collaboration with AT&T, seeks to empower older adults with the essential skills needed to navigate today's increasing digital world.

As one of only 50 senior centers selected across the country, Etowah Senior Center will be offering a series of in-person workshops designed to guide older adults through modules that will help build confidence in using technology. These modules will cover a range of topics, including online safety, communication tools, and accessing essential services online.

The goal of this program is to ensure that older adults have access to the knowledge and resources they need to stay connected, informed, and safe while using the internet. Workshops and support will be available in both English and Spanish, ensuring accessibility for all participants.

The first workshop was held on Friday, February 21 which was an introduction to Android cellphones. The second workshop will be February 28th at 12:00. This one will cover Cybersecurity. It is very important that you know how to protect your personal information online. You will learn some tips on how to keep your information secure. There will also be workshops that will include an introduction to Email, Basics to Video Conferencing, Using an IOS (Apple iPhone), Digital Citizenship, Connecting with Kindness, Accounts and Passwords, and Connecting with a Purpose.

Each participant that is present for any workshop will receive one chance to win an Apple iPad valued at \$347.00. The iPad will be given away during the last workshop. Tennessee Wesleyan University is honored to host The Rev. Dr. Dennis C. Dickerson as this year's Heritage Day speaker. A distinguished historian and Retired General Officer in the African Methodist Episcopal Church, Dr. Dickerson has dedicated his career to studying American labor his-

tory, the U.S. civil rights movement, and African American religious history.

Dr. Dickerson has authored several books, including *Out of the Crucible: Black Steel Workers in Western Pennsylvania, 1875-1980, Militant Mediator: Whitney M. Young, Jr.*, and *The African Methodist Episcopal Church: A History*. His extensive research has been supported by prestigious organizations such as the National Endowment for the Humanities and the Rockefeller Foundation.

Dr. Dickerson will deliver two addresses: Monday, February 24, at 7 p.m. in the Johnson Event Center at Colloms Campus Center and Tuesday, February 25, at 11 a.m. in Townsend Auditorium, where he will speak on "A Wesleyan Warrant for Global Reconstruction." Both events are free and open to the public.
