Preschool Registration Opens for Local Schools

Public schools across the region are gearing up for preschool registration, offering families an opportunity to give their children an early start in education. While preschool is not mandatory in Tennessee, it is a voluntary program available to children who will be 4 years old by August 15. Parents interested in enrolling their children will need to provide a birth certificate, immunization records, and proof of residency. Registration dates vary by school district:

- Athens City Schools Registration is currently open at the Central Office on Crestway Drive.
- Etowah City School April 2 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. More appointments are available by calling the school office.
- McMinn County Schools April 7 at Calhoun, E.K. Baker, and Rogers Creek, and on April 8 at Englewood, Mountain View, and Niota.

Educators emphasize the importance of early childhood education in promoting healthy brain development and social skills. Preschool provides children with a structured environment where they can engage in imaginative play, storytelling, singing, and early learning activities, setting the stage for future academic success.



Gas Prices Drop Slightly; McMinn County Sees Lower Averages



The national average price for a gallon of gas has dropped by a penny since last week, now sitting at \$3.11, thanks in part to lower oil prices. However, some drivers may experience fluctuations at the pump as markets and retailers respond to tariff news and the transition to summer-grade gasoline, which is more expensive to produce.

As of Thursday, the national average for gas is 2 cents lower than a month ago and 27 cents lower than this time last year. In McMinn County, the average price per gallon is significantly lower than the national average, standing at \$2.67.

Chargerettes win 4th consecutive region title with Karina Bystry's record-breaking performance



The McMinn Central Chargerettes defeated Meigs County 70-28 to win their 4th consecutive region title. Karina Bystry scored 31 points and led the team with 5 assists. She moved past Oneida's Brynae Laxton (914 in 1993-94) for 4th place in single season scoring.

Her 923 points this season place her 1 point shy of Upperman's Akira Levy (924 in 2017-18). Malea Masingale scored 11 points and led the team with 5 steals. Camryn Loden and Reagan Baker both scored 9 points, and Baker led the team with 8 rebounds.

The Chargerettes host the sectional Saturday at 7pm against Region 1-2A runner up Alcoa who lost to Gatlinburg Pittman 72-63 in OT. The sectional winner advances to next week's Blue Cross Championships on the campus of MTSU in Murfreesboro.

Camryn Loden, Reagan Baker, Alahna Powell, Malea Masingale, and Karina Bystry (MVP) were named to the All Region 2-2A team.

Lady Vols Dominate Texas A&M in SEC Tournament Opener



No. 18/17 Tennessee shook off a slow start to overpower Texas A&M with a dominant performance, securing a 77-37 victory in the opening round of the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament on Wednesday at Bon Secours Wellness Arena.

Redshirt sophomore Talaysia Cooper, returning from a lower-body injury, led the Lady Vols with 19 points, eight rebounds, three assists, and three steals off the bench. Jewel Spear and Zee Spearman added 11 points each, while Samara Spencer chipped in 10.

After trailing 13-11 at the end of the first quarter, Tennessee took control in the second, outscoring the Aggies 21-6 to take a 32-19 halftime lead. The Lady Vols continued to dominate in the second half, going on multiple scoring runs and shooting 55% from the field in the third quarter to extend their lead to 60-28. By the final buzzer, Tennessee had outscored A&M by 42 points over the last three quarters, sealing a decisive 40-point win.

The victory advances the No. 9 seed Lady Vols (22-8) to the second round, where they will face No. 8 seed Vanderbilt (21-9, 8-8 SEC) at 11 a.m. ET on Thursday. The game will be televised on SEC Network and available via Lady Vol Network radio stations and UTSports.com audio stream.
