Brush Fire ignites in Englewood after mowing incident



A routine roadside mowing operation by the McMinn County Highway Department took an unexpected turn Wednesday afternoon when a spark from a mower blade striking a rock ignited a fire along County Road 508.

The fire quickly spread to a nearby property, burning approximately one-fifth of an acre before the Englewood Rural Fire Department responded to the scene and extinguished the flames.

The incident occurred around 2 p.m., highlighting the potential fire hazards posed by dry conditions and roadside maintenance work. No injuries were reported, and crews were able to prevent the fire from causing further damage.


The Englewood Rural Fire Department urges residents and workers to remain cautious, especially during dry weather, as even a small spark can lead to a fire hazard.



Meigs County has sixth-highest unemployment as rates rise across TN

Tennessee's unemployment rates rose in 87 of 95 counties in January, with *Meigs County recording the 6th highest rate at 5.8%*, according to the <u>Tennessee De-</u> partment of Labor and Workforce Development.

Statewide, 82 counties remained below 5% unemployment. Williamson County had the lowest rate at 2.8%, while Perry County reported the highest at 7.6%.


Tennessee's overall unemployment rate stayed at 3.7%, with the national rate at 4%.
