This month, Athens native Sam Goodin will graduate from Tennessee Wesleyan University with a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration with a focus in Industrial Management. His academic success is remarkable, but it is his perseverance through profound adversity that has made a lasting impact on the TWU community. Sam, the son of Chad and Amy Goodin and brother to Katie and Jack, also credits his longtime girlfriend, Addison Smith, as an essential source of strength.

A 2022 McMinn County High School graduate, Sam excelled as a student-athlete in foot-

ball, cross-country, and baseball, earning All-District Honors and helping lead his team to its first-ever state appearance. He also devoted more than 800 service hours through mission work, local charities, and summer programs. At 15, he launched Goodin Brothers Firewood, serving over 100 customers.

Sam grew up dreaming of playing college baseball, a dream briefly realized before life changed course. During his first year at TWU, he was diagnosed with Desmoplastic Small Round Cell Tumor, a rare and aggressive cancer. For three years, he endured chemotherapy, radiation, and major surgeries while continuing his studies.




