TBI Investigating Officer-Involved Shooting in Sweetwater

A state investigation is underway following an officer-involved shooting in Sweetwater Monday night that resulted in the death of a suspect.

According to the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation, officers with the Sweetwater Police Department responded around 7:30 p.m. to a reported shoplifting incident at a business in the 900 block of South Main Street. Officers located the suspect, and a foot pursuit followed.

During the encounter, the suspect reportedly brandished a knife and advanced toward officers. One officer fired, striking the individual. The man was transported to a hospital, where he was pronounced dead. No officers were injured.

The Sweetwater Police Department confirmed late Monday that a detective was involved in the shooting but released limited details at that time.

TBI special agents are leading the investigation into the circumstances surrounding the shooting, with assistance from the McMinn County Sheriff's Office and the 10th Judicial District Attorney's Office. *Source: WATE*

McMinn County Tourism Attractions Awarded Grants

McMinn County is celebrating a wave of new investments in its tourism sector, with multiple attractions and municipalities receiving significant grants to preserve history, enhance cultural venues, and expand outdoor recreation. These projects highlight the county's commitment to enriching visitor experiences and supporting community vitality.

The Englewood Textile Museum has been awarded \$29,800 from the Tennessee State Museum Capital Improvement and Maintenance Grant. The funding will be used for brick painting and exterior wall repairs as well as the rebuilding of an interior wall, ensuring the museum's historic structure remains sound for future generations.

The McMinn County Living Heritage Museum received \$54,280 from the Tennessee State Museum Capital Improvement Fund to install a new roof, gutters, and downspouts, protecting the museum's collection and improving safety for visitors.

In Etowah, the city secured a \$100,000 grant to renovate the historic Gem Theater, a cultural cornerstone that hosts performances, films, and community events. Renovations will enhance the theater's role as a hub for arts and entertainment.

Meanwhile, the City of Calhoun is completing its 2024 Tourism Enhancement Grant project, totaling \$87,191.37, to improve the Hiwassee River Blueway Access Point. The upgrades will be completed in time for spring river adventures in 2026, expanding opportunities for paddling, fishing, and eco-tourism.

Athens and Main Street Athens have also received a \$300,000 Downtown Improvement Grant. The funding will assist property owners with building and façade improvements, revitalizing the downtown area and enhancing its appeal for businesses, residents, and visitors. *Source: Brianna Baker, McMinn County EDA & Tourism*



McMinn County Elections Administrator Earns State Certification



McMinn County Administrator of Elections Bridgett Prichard has been recognized by Tennessee Secretary of State Tre Hargett (Left) and State Coordinator of Elections Mark Goins for passing the Administrator of Elections Certification Exam.

The exam, administered by the Secretary of State's Division of Elections in Nashville, is offered at least once each year and includes a comprehensive written assessment covering statutory election requirements, voter registration, and Election Day procedures.

Before taking the exam, administrators must complete extensive training on 40 topics related to election law. Passing the certification demonstrates the knowledge and preparation required to administer elections at the county level.

State officials noted that Prichard's certification helps ensure elections in McMinn County are conducted accurately, securely, and with integrity. Tennessee has been ranked first in election integrity for the fourth consecutive year by the Heritage Foundation.




